- If you have not used assembled or dismantled a mobile access tower before familiarise yourself with the equipment's components before you start the main task.
- Plan your work and think ahead to make sure that you will always be working safely.
- Prepare a risk assessment for the task.
- You should have at least the following items of personal protective equipment:
 - Hard hat with chin strap to EN397
 - Boots or protective footwear to a minimum EN345
- The mobile access tower must not be used by minors, or by anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- This equipment is designed for use by an able bodied adult. Anyone with either temporary or permanent disability must seek expert advice before using it.
- If the mobile access tower is to remain in position when unattended, for example overnight, then you should make it secure to prevent unauthorised use.
