Using the Belle Minimix Cement Mixer

STARTING THE ENGINE

- Check that the engine and machine controls are set correctly.
- Make sure that you hold the machine firmly so it will not move when you pull the starter.
- Pull the starter handle slowly until you can feel that the starter has engaged with the engine, then pull it quickly and strongly. Don't pull it too far, or it may break
- Guide the cord back into place so that it recoils correctly.

USING THE BELLE MINIMIX CEMENT MIXER

- Wear your protective equipment including ear defenders, dust mask, goggles and safety
- The engine must be running all the time there is a mix in the drum.
- 3. Do not move the mixer while the drum is full.
- Stop the engine if leaving the machine unattended.
- You must clean the mixer and especially the drum as soon as you have finished work, before the mix goes hard.
- If your equipment does not work properly do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire
